<p>This is to notify you of a new Recall Campaign to check the headlamp aim in 2 Model Year (“MY”) 2020 AMG GT-Class (190 platform) vehicles. The recall campaign will be visible on the www.safercar.gov website and may generate questions from customers. Affected VINs will be flagged in VMI as “PENDING” on December 18, 2020.</p>			
Background			
Issue	Mercedes-Benz AG (“MBAG”), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year (“MY”) 2020 AMG GT-Class vehicles (190 platform), the headlamps might be aimed slightly too high which might not meet current production specifications or fulfill the requirements of FMVSS 108 (Lamp, Reflective Devices and Associated equipment - §571.108 S10.18.9.1.1 & 4). Incorrectly aimed headlamps might create glare for oncoming traffic, which could increase the risk of a crash.		
What We’re Doing	MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will check the headlamp aim on the affected vehicles and corrected it, if necessary.		
Parts	Remedy is not available at this time. An additional notification will be sent once the remedy is available.

Once the remedy is available, the vehicles will be flagged as “OPEN” and Work Instructions will be available in Star TekInfo. Once the repair is complete the vehicle may be sold or leased.</p> <p>Loaner and demonstrator vehicles may continue to be driven, but must not be retailed until repaired.</p> <p>Additionally, given this notice, it is a violation of Federal Law for car rental companies to rent MY20 AMG GT-Class vehicles covered by this notification until the vehicle has been repaired.</p>
