# Equipment Safety Recall Y85 / NHTSA 21E-093 Trailer Reverse Steering Control Module

### Remedy Available

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced an equipment safety recall on certain Trailer Reverse Steering Control Modules (TRSCMs).

- Mopar Trailer Reverse Steering Control Module 68423566AE
- Mopar Trailer Reverse Steering Control Module 68423566AF

### **Subject**

Some of the above TRSCMs may prevent the rearview image from displaying under certain conditions. An Electronic Throttle Control warning indicator may also be illuminated in the instrument panel cluster. If installed in a vehicle, the vehicle operator will notice that the rearview image is not displayed if attempting to reference the image while backing. If this warning is not heeded, backing without verifying it is safe to do so could lead to an increased risk of injury to people outside the vehicle.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.111 S6.2.6 which requires that "The rear visibility system default to the rearview image being visible, and meet the requirements of FMVSS 571.111 S6.2.1 (field of view) and S6.2.2 (image size) at the beginning of each backing event, regardless of any modifications to the field of view that the driver had previously selected."

# Repair

FCA US will repurchase all suspect trailer reverse steering control modules.

# **Parts Return**

Suspect trailer reverse steering control modules must be returned.

### IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

### **Trailer Reverse Steering Control Module**

Dear [Name],

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

FCA US has decided that certain Trailer Reverse Steering Control Modules (TRSCMs) fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 111 - Rearview mirrors.

- Mopar Trailer Reverse Steering Control Module 68423566AE
- Mopar Trailer Reverse Steering Control Module 68423566AF

It is extremely important to take steps now to repair your vehicle to ensure the safety of you and your passengers.

#### WHY DOES MY VEHICLE NEED REPAIRS?

FCA records indicate that you may have purchased or had installed a Mopar replacement TRSCM for your vehicle [1]. Some of the above TRSCMs may prevent the rearview image from displaying under certain conditions. An Electronic Throttle Control warning indicator may also be illuminated in the instrument panel cluster. If installed in a vehicle, the vehicle operator will notice that the rearview image is not displayed if attempting to reference the image while backing. If this warning is not heeded, backing without verifying it is safe to do so could lead to an increased risk of injury to people outside the vehicle.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.111 S6.2.6 which requires that "The rear visibility system default to the rearview image being visible, and meet the requirements of FMVSS 571.111 S6.2.1 (field of view) and S6.2.2 (image size) at the beginning of each backing event, regardless of any modifications to the field of view that the driver had previously selected."

#### HOW DO I RESOLVE THIS IMPORTANT SAFETY ISSUE?

FCA US is conducting a voluntary equipment safety recall on all affected parts to repurchase, exchange, or update suspect TRSCMs. Be sure to bring the TRSCM module with this letter to your dealership. Your vehicle may also be included in the Y80 Safety Recall for repair of the same TRSCM. To do this, your dealer will update the TRSCM software. The estimated repair time is 30 minutes. In addition, your dealer will require your vehicle for proper check-in, preparation, and check-out during your visit, which may require more time. Your time is important to us, so we recommend that you schedule a service appointment to minimize your inconvenience. Please bring this letter with you to your dealership.

#### WHAT IF I ALREADY PAID TO HAVE THIS REPAIR COMPLETED?

If you have already experienced this specific condition and have paid to have it repaired, you may visit <a href="www.fcarecallreimbursement.com">www.fcarecallreimbursement.com</a> to submit your reimbursement request online. [3] Once we receive and verify the required documents, reimbursement will be sent to you within 60 days. If you have had previous repairs performed and/or already received reimbursement, you may still need to have the recall repair performed.
