Chronology:

On February 14, 2021, it was discovered that the sidewall/chafer component was labeled incorrectly as it left the extrusion process. The incorrect component was inadvertently delivered to a tire building machine and tires were produced. After the subject tires were produced, the tire builder discovered the error and tire production and curing were suspended and tires were held for inspection. At that time, it was believed that all of the subject tires were identified and scrapped. However, after completing inspection of tires shipped to several distribution centers, it was discovered during the week of August 16, 2021,by reviewing shipping records that 20 tires may have shipped to one customer directly from the plant. There have been no claims associated with any of these tires.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: Cooper Tire & Rubber Company (Cooper Tire) will initiate a voluntary safety recall of the subject tires. Cooper Tire will contact registered owners that purchased tires of the specified date range by registered mail. Customer correspondence will explain the issue, and include instructions on how to obtain replacement tires, as well as instructions for collecting reimbursement for remedies made prior to the recall. All tires found to have an affected DOT identification number will be replaced and will be scrapped according to applicable law. Consumers who have had their tires replaced before this recall may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

> In accordance with the provisions of 49 C.F.R. § 573.6(c) (9) (i), Cooper Tire & Rubber Company will make dealers aware of the legal requirements associated with the prohibition against the sale of recalled tires through a Dealer Notification Letter that will be submitted to the agency separately pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 573.6(c)(10). The program for disposing of all recalled tires returned to Cooper Tire & Rubber Company will comply with applicable state and local laws and regulations regarding the disposal of tires, and to the extent possible, tires will be channeled into a category of positive reuse or another alternative beneficial non-vehicular reuse, instead of being disposed of in landfills.

The improper sidewall component was limited to one reel and that reel was consumed within the impacted serial week.
