1. Work Instructions for Tire Distributors/Tire Service Facilities:

- □ Refer to DTNA recall bulletin FL872 for detailed recall repair instructions.
- □ Check for a recall completion sticker on the passenger-side door jamb. If a completion sticker is present, then the FL872 recall has already been completed, and no further action is required.
- □ Check steer axle tires.
 - If neither tire is Bridgestone, then complete an inspection invoice, and send to Empire Truck.
 - If either tire is Bridgestone, then proceed with the FL872 work instructions, replacing both tires.
- □ Once recall repair (or inspection) is complete, obtain a customer signature, and submit an invoice to tirerecall@empiretruck.com.

2. Invoice Requirements

- □ Full 17-Digit VIN#
- DOT Tire Identification Numbers (TIN's): From Removed Bridgestone Tires
- □ Mileage/KM
- □ Replacement Tire Description: Brand, Model, Size, Ply Rating
- **Tire Replacement Cost**: \$1,200 for two tires, \$40 for inspection-only, \$0 if completion sticker present
- □ Labor Description
- □ **Misc. Parts, Labor, and/or Cost** (usually not applicable)
- □ Customer Signature & Customer Name
