Background				
Issue	certain Mo the right a ISOFIX bra missing, th increasing	Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year ("MY") 2021 CLA-Class vehicles (118 platform) and A-Class vehicles (177 platform), the right anchoring bar of the ISOFIX bracket on the right rear seat for attaching the child restraint to the ISOFIX bracket might be missing. If the right anchoring bar of the ISOFIX bracket for the right rear seat is missing, the child restraint cannot be properly secured to the seat using the ISOFIX securing system, increasing the risk of injury for a child in the child restraint.		
What We're Doing		MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will check the rear right side ISOFIX bracket on the affected vehicles and replace the bracket, if necessary.
