SAFETY RECALL NOTICE: 21V097

TO: Affected KME Dealers

KME has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2013-2020 KME vehicles manufactured from October 2012 through November 2019.

Vehicles included in this recall may have insufficient welds used to attach suspension mounts and torque rod mounts to the rear axle. The welds may break causing the mounts to become separated from the axle.

KME or its dealers will inspect and verify the integrity of the welds per the weld instructions and will repair any defects found at no cost to the vehicle owner. Estimated time for the remedy is 1.5 hours for inspection and 30 hours for repair if required.

Please be reminded that it is a violation of Federal law for you deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment covered by this notification until this defect has been remedied. Substantial civil penalties apply to violations of this law.
