Descriptive Information: Some 2020-2021 MY Ram ProMaster City vehicles may have been built with an

antilock braking system module ("ABS module") with a damaged damper membrane.

The suspect period began on August 15, 2020, when the first vehicle produced for the US market was built with a suspect ABS module, and ended on October 6, 2020, when the last vehicle produced for the US market was built with a suspect ABS module. The suspect period was determined using supplier and vehicle production traceability

records.

Similar vehicles not included in this recall were built before or after the suspect

period or are not equipped with a suspect ABS module.

- On February 8, 2021, FCA Italy was informed by the supplier about a potential issue regarding the ABS module.
- On February 9, 2021, FCA Italy Quality began analyzing assembly production records and supplier information to determine the scope of vehicles potentially affected.
- As of March 2, 2021, FCA US LLC ("FCA US") has identified zero customer assistance records, zero warranty claims, and zero field reports potentially relating to this issue.
- As of March 2, 2021, FCA US is not aware of any accidents or injuries potentially relating to this issue.
- On March 2, 2021, FCA Italy determined, through the Vehicle Regulations Committee, to conduct a voluntary safety recall of the affected vehicles.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to

replace the ABS module.

FCA US has a longstanding policy and practice of reimbursing owners who have incurred the cost of repairing a problem that subsequently becomes the subject of a field action. To ensure consistency, FCA US, as part of the owner letter, will request that customers send the original receipt and/or other adequate proof of payment to the company for confirmation of the

expense.
