Description of the Defect: General Motors has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety

exists in certain 2021 model year Cadillac Escalade and Escalade ESV vehicles;

Chevrolet Suburban and Tahoe vehicles; and GMC Yukon and Yukon XL

vehicles with third-row seating. During installation of the third-row seat, one or both third-row outboard seat belts may have been inadvertently entrapped in or misrouted behind the outboard seat-folding mechanism. A seat belt in

this condition may be damaged by the seat-folding mechanism.
