

PARTS AND SERVICE BULLETIN UPDATE

Please be advised that as of today, May 11, 2021, parts are available for the 2019 Fit and 2019 HR-V models through the controlled parts ordering system under the following service bulletins:

- 21-023, Safety Recall: 2019 Fit Fuel Pump Motor
- 21-024, Safety Recall: 2019 HR-V (2WD) Fuel Pump Motor
- 21-025, Safety Recall: 2019 HR-V (AWD) Fuel Pump Motor

These bulletins include parts, repair, and warranty information related to this recall.

SUMMARY

On March 25, 2021, American Honda notified NHTSA of a stop sale and safety recall for certain 2018-2019 CR-V, 2019-2020 Accord, Civic Hatchback, Insight, 2019 Accord Hybrid, Civic, Civic Si, Civic Type R, Fit, HR-V, Odyssey, Passport, Pilot and Ridgeline units for fuel pump modules manufactured with defective impellers. A defective impeller may cause the fuel pump to become inoperative which could prevent the engine from starting or stall the engine while driving, increasing the risk of a crash. Refer to your eResponsibility report or do an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.

Please note that as of today, parts are available for all models in this expansion. The placeholder service bulletin will be removed at this time. Thank you.

Failure to repair a vehicle as necessary prior to sale may subject your dealership to claims or lawsuits.

As always, be sure to do an iN VIN status inquiry for all vehicles passing through your dealership to determine eligibility for any open campaigns.
