

MACK TRUCKS RECALL ALERT



Subject: Safety Recall SC0423, Non-Compliance Electronic Stability Control
Recall Number: SRA-M423
Date: April 16, 2021
Applicable Markets: U.S. Canada

Description

Mack Trucks, Inc. (Mack) is recalling certain 2018-2022 Anthem (AN), Granite (GR/GU), and Pinnacle (CHU/CXU/PI) vehicles equipped with "camelback" rear suspension and electronic stability control. The vehicles may not stay in their lane at certain speeds. As such, these vehicles fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) number 136, "Electronic Stability Control Systems on Heavy Vehicles." As a result, there is an increased risk of a vehicle related crash at those speeds.

The vehicles will be repaired by reprogramming the anti-lock brake control module.

Model and Model Years Affected

- Certain Mack 2018 – 2022 Anthem, Granite and Pinnacle vehicles.

Vehicle Quantities

- 557, All US.

Dealer Responsibilities

- The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.
- Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Notification Release Schedule

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal on April 16, 2021
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before April 21, 2021
