April 19, 2021 Results of investigation presented to Product Safety Working Group (PSWG). PSWG views the issue as a potential safety defect and decides to raise it to Product Safety Committee (PSC) April 22, 2021 Mack Trucks Product Safety Committee (PSC) determines that a safety defect exists.

There are two reports of steering lock up at low speed. 1st report received on Dec. 16, 2020. 2nd report received the week of Feb. 15, 2021.

How Remedy Component Differs The transfer case has the required amount of oil.

Identify How/When Recall Condition When the potential issue was discovered in December 2020, the supplier was Corrected in Production: and Mack reviewed all transfer cases at our production facility. All parts checked were good - had the required amount of oil in the transfer case. Further review of the suppliers records suggest that 8 transfer cases in total did not receive the correct amount of oil.
