Dear BMW Owner / Lessee:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. BMW AG has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Model Year 2021 BMW 3 Series and M3 models. Our records indicate that you are the owner of a potentially affected vehicle.

Why are we contacting you?

We are pleased to inform you that we are ready to perform this recall. If you have not had this recall performed, please contact your authorized BMW center immediately to schedule an appointment. Please visit <u>bmwusa.com/dealer</u> to locate your nearest BMW center.

What could happen?

The front seat safety belt buckle assembly may not have been installed according to specifications. Over time, it could loosen, potentially affecting restraint capability, which could increase the risk of injury in a crash.

If you are not the only driver of this vehicle, please advise all other drivers and passengers of this important information.

What will BMW do?
