certain 2020 and 2021 Interstate 19 motorhomes that may cause the wire to become hot and burn up before the 40A breaker has a chance to disconnect the

circuit from power.

Description of the Safety Risk: Wires that are inadequately fused which may result in the wires overheating

resulting in a fire. Personal injury could occur as a result.

Description of the Cause: Because of the breaker being mislabeled the wires were transposed and

connected to the incorrect positions on the 24-Hour Buss Bar (M-4) circuit breaker that may cause improper overcurrent protection for the 12V circuits

powered by this breaker block.

4/28/2020 - During an audit it was discovered there were transposed wires connected to incorrect positions on the 24-Hour Buss Bar (M-4) circuit breaker. 4/29/2021 - Discussed the labeling/wiring discrepancy with the motorized engineering department, and agreed to start an investigation. 5/6/2021 - The electrical engineering department and the Airstream Safety Committee convened to discuss the issue and determined a recall was necessary.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: An inspection of the 24-Hour Buss Bar (M-4) circuit breaker will occur.

The circuit breaker will be relabeled and the wires will be relocated to the

correct breakers. This will be done at no cost to the customer.

How Remedy Component Differs The recalled units will have wires connected to the incorrect breakers, and from Recalled Component: the non-recall units will either have an Ultimate Power System terminal

block, or will have the wires paired with the correct breaker. The wires, as

well as the breakers are labeled.
