**Replace Passenger Airbag Module** 

Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year ("MY") 2020 GLB (247 platform) vehicles, the mounting of the inflator within the frontal passenger airbag module as well as the fastening of the airbag fabric to the module might not meet specifications. In this case, in the event of a crash necessitating airbag deployment, the airbag's fabric might tear at the mounting location, which could impair the airbag's ability to protect the passenger, increasing the risk of injury. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will replace the frontal passenger airbag module on the affected vehicles.

Prior to performing this Recall Campaign:

- VMI must always be checked before performing campaigns to verify that the campaign is required on a specific vehicle. Always check for any other open campaigns, and perform accordingly.
- Please review the entire Recall Campaign bulletin and follow the repair procedure exactly as described.

Please note that Recall Campaigns **do not expire** and may also be performed on a vehicle with a vehicle status indicator.

Approximately 17 vehicles are involved.

### Replace front passenger airbag

Model 247

Before beginning work, *no SRS fault message* may be *present* in the instrument cluster!

If a SRS fault message is present before beginning work, it must be rectified.

The fault rectification may not be invoiced together with the recall!

#### Work procedure

- 1. Disconnect ground line from on-board electrical system battery.
- 2. Replace front passenger airbag (AR91.60-P-0664MFB).
- **3.** Connect ground line to on-board electrical system battery.
- **4.** Switch ignition to position **1**. To do so, press start button once without touching the brake pedal. Check whether airbag indicator lamp **(A, figure 1)** permanently goes off **(B, figure 2)** after a few seconds.
  - The SRS check after airbag replacement is thus completely ensured!
