Dear Valued Mercedes-Benz Sprinter Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz Sprinter vans, has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model Year 2019 - 2021 Mercedes-Benz Sprinter vehicles. Our records indicate that your vehicle is included in the affected population of vehicles.

What is the concern?



On certain Mercedes-Benz Sprinter vans the MBUX multimedia system software might not meet specifications. Under very specific conditions, the MBUX multimedia system might not start and the display might remain black, or could reboot unintentionally after 50 seconds of initial startup. Accordingly, the rearview camera image might not be displayed or the display might be interrupted, which could increase a risk of a crash or injury.

Unfortunately, the software to remedy this issue is currently not yet available.

We are working to obtain the necessary software to correct this condition as quickly as possible. When the software update becomes available, we will send you another letter asking you to take your vehicle to an authorized Mercedes-Benz Sprinter dealer to have the recall completed free of charge.
