

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This notice applies to your vehicle, VIN:	
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Dear General Motors Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

General Motors has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2021 model year Buick Enclave and Chevrolet Traverse vehicles. As a result, GM is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for this inconvenience. However, we are concerned about your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.

IMPORTANT

- Your vehicle is involved in GM recall N212340220.
- Schedule an appointment with your GM dealer.
- This service will be performed for you at no charge.

Why is your vehicle being recalled?

Certain vehicles may have received incorrect sensing diagnostic module (SDM) calibration software during service by a dealer that may affect the timing or level of frontal airbag deployment in certain crashes.

What will we

Your GM dealer will update the calibration software in the sensing diagnostic module (SDM). This service will be performed for you at **no charge**. Because of service scheduling requirements, it is likely that your dealer will need your vehicle longer than the actual service correction time of approximately 20 minutes.

What should you do?

You should contact your GM dealer to arrange a service appointment as soon as possible.
