Dealers will replace the air bag module cover with an improved part. The air bag and inflator will not be replaced. There will be no charge for this service to vehicle owners. Due to the particular nature of this concern, customers would not have been able to incur warrantable costs related to remedying this defect. Therefore, Mazda does not intend to offer a

reimbursement plan.

How Remedy Component Differs The improved logo on the air bag module cover for the remedy

Identify How/When Recall Condition Beginning in June 2006, steering wheel logos were made of a polyester was Corrected in Production: material to improve the logo appearance. The improved logos and are not subject to deterioration, so this material change also corrected the defect.

Description of Recall Schedule: Notification to dealers is expected to occur on or before July 7, 2021.

Mailing of owner notification letters is expected to be completed on or before August 28, 2021. Due to parts logistics constraints prior to August 28 2021, Guam and Saipan will receive parts available Owner letters while US and Puerto Rico will receive interim "no parts" Owner letters. A phased recall launch is planned for U.S. and Puerto Rico from October 2021 through December 2021 with parts available Owner letters being mailed throughout this time period. Priority will be placed on older

model years in areas of high heat and high humidity.
