This is to notify you of a new Recall Campaign to replace the LED headlamp on <u>1,467</u> Model Year (“MY”) 2018-2021 GLE-Class (167 platform), C-Class (205 platform), A-Class (177 platform) and GLB-Class (247 platform) vehicles. The recall campaign will be visible on the www.safercar.gov website and may generate questions from customers. Affected VINs will be flagged in VMI as “PENDING” on July 12, 2021 .			
Background			
Issue	Mercedes-Benz AG (“MBAG”), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year (“MY”) 2018-2021 GLE-Class (167 platform), C-Class (205 platform), A-Class (177 platform) and GLB-Class (247 platform) vehicles with “LED” headlamps where a recalibration of the headlamp was necessary due to a repair, the adjustment of the headlamps might not meet current production specifications or fulfill the requirements of FMVSS 108 (Lamp, Reflective Devices and Associated equipment - §571.108 S10.14.6). In this case, the light intensity of the high beam, low beam, and the model specific turn signal indicator may not conform to the requirements of FMVSS 108, which could increase the risk of a crash.		
What We’re Doing	An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will replace the LED headlamps on the affected vehicles.		
Parts	Remedy is not available at this time. An additional notification will be sent once the remedy is available.

Once the remedy is available, the vehicles will be flagged as “OPEN” and Work Instructions will be available in Star TekInfo. Once the repair is complete the vehicle may be sold or leased.			
Loaner and demonstrator vehicles may continue to be driven, but must not be retailed until repaired. As a matter of normal service process, please check for other repair measures which might be applicable to the vehicle(s)			
Additionally, given this notice, it is <u>a violation of Federal Law</u> for <u>car rental companies</u> to rent new MY18-21 GLE-Class, C-Class, A-Class, GLB-Class vehicles covered by this notification until the vehicle has been repaired.
