may exist in certain 2016 – 2021 Chevrolet Malibu and 2019 – 2021 Cadillac XT4 vehicles. In rare cases, plant technicians performing a repair during the assembly process may not have installed a fastener required to fully secure a rear seat belt retractor. This condition may exist on the right-hand side of

affected Malibu vehicles or either side of affected XT4 vehicles.
