

Repair Available - Safety Recall 20DB / Underhood Fuel Line & Connector

If the quick connector detaches from the fuel line, it may lead to a loss of motive power (engine stalling) without warning, and may also cause fuel to leak into the engine compartment. Stalling can lead to a vehicle crash. Leaking fuel, in the presence of an ignition source, can result in a fire. If this condition is present in the vehicle, occupants may notice a fuel odor inside the vehicle, or vehicle may stall without warning. If this happens, customers are advised to contact an authorized Volkswagen dealer without delay and make arrangements to have the vehicle inspected/repaired.				
Repair: Parts Department:	 REPAIR AVAILABLE – August 24, 2021 / Inspect the affected fuel line connection and, if necessary replace the fuel line and connector. See ELSA/ServiceNet for complete repair & claiming instructions Check both the daily Campaign Open Inventory report <u>and</u> OMD for affected vehicles in inventory. Verify OPEN status in ELSA <u>on the day of repair</u>. Repair every affected inventory vehicle <u>before delivery to consumers</u>. Due to the very low replacement rate expected, there will be no parts allocation. Please see the campaign circular for complete parts information. DO NOT order parts unless absolutely needed to complete a vehicle repair.

IMPORTANT REMINDER: VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

<u>New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:</u> It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

<u>Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:</u> Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
