This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

FCA US has decided that certain [2021 (LA) Dodge Challenger] vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.101 Controls and Displays S5.3 requires vehicles to "illuminate telltales and their identification sufficiently to make them visible to the driver under daylight and nighttime driving conditions."

It is extremely important to take steps now to repair your vehicle to ensure the safety of you and your passengers.

#### WHY DOES MY VEHICLE NEED REPAIRS?

The Instrument Panel Cluster (IPC) on your vehicle [1] has an incorrect software version. The affected vehicles do not illuminate their safety system status indicators sufficiently in both daylight and nighttime driving conditions. Suspect vehicles included in this recall may not illuminate the required safety system status indicators. Without visible safety system indicators, a driver may not receive information regarding vehicle safety, increasing the risk of injury or a crash.

#### HOW DO I RESOLVE THIS IMPORTANT SAFETY ISSUE?

FCA US will reprogram the suspect instrument cluster in your vehicle [2] with the correct software version free of charge (parts and labor). The estimated repair time is 1.5 hours. In addition, your dealer will require your vehicle for proper check-in, preparation, and check-out during your visit, which may require more time. Your time is important to us, so we recommend that you schedule a service appointment to minimize your inconvenience. Please bring this letter with you to your dealership.

#### CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS

The State of California requires the completion of emission recall repairs prior to vehicle registration renewal. Be sure to save this form since the California Department of Motor Vehicles may require that you supply it as proof that the Emission Recall has been performed.
