Discharge Chute Retainer Block Replacement Kit (IK00-4126)

Background:

Vermeer Corporation has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2021 Vermeer BC900XL, BC1000XL and BC1200XL brush chippers.

POSSIBLE LOSS OF DISCHARGE CHUTE AND RISK OF CRASH

The retainer blocks which secure the discharge chute may not have been properly manufactured, which could result in loose bolts and possible separation of discharge chute from the brush chipper.

DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY

When towing the brush chipper on public roadways, **death or serious injury** may result if discharge chute becomes separated from the brush chipper and strikes another vehicle or pedestrian on the roadway. While operating the brush chipper

on jobsites, crew member(s) may be injured if struck by the discharge chute. Property or equipment damage may also occur.

IMMEDIATE MACHINE MODIFICATIONS REQUIRED

IK00-4126 has been created to provide the necessary parts and instructions to replace the discharge chute retainer block. **The kit must be installed as soon as possible.**
