- CONNECT THE PROVIDED LP GAS HOSE TO THE QUICK DISCONNECT UNDER THE TRAILER
- CONNECT THE OTHER END OF THE PROVIDED LP GAS HOSE TO THE EXTERIOR GRILL
- TURN ON THE LP GAS SUPPLY AND OPEN THE BOTH QUICK DISCONNECT VALVES
- SPRAY WITH SOAPY WATER OR ANOTHER LP GAS LEAK DETECTOR FLUID
- VERIFY THE LP QUICK DISCONNECT ON THE EXTERIOR GRILL IS POINTED VERTICALLY DOWN





STEP 3: IF THERE IS LEAKING LP GAS, REPAIR THE FITTING;

- TIGHTEN THE QUICK DISCONNECT THAT IS ATTACHED TO THE EXTERIOR GRILL
- VERIFY THE LP QUICK DISCONNECT ON THE EXTERIOR GRILL IS POINTED VERTICALLY DOWN
- SPRAY WITH SOAPY WATER OR ANOTHER LP GAS LEAK DETECTOR FLUID UNTIL THERE ARE NO BUBBLES PRESENT THAT INDICATE A LEAK

STEP 4: IGNITE THE EXTERIOR GRILL AND BURN OFF THE APPLIANCE;

STEP 5: CLAIM THE APPROPRIATE CODES LISTED AT THE TOP.
