Chronology:

At the end of August, Porsche gained knowledge that the subject vehicles are programmed with pre-collision automatic hazard warning lamp activation logic that may exceed the automatic activation functionality permitted by FMVSS No. 108. This feature is permitted in other markets.

Subsequently, Porsche carefully analyzed whether this feature (which Porsche believes provides a net safety benefit) was in conflict with FMVSS No. 108. This included the analysis of interpretation letters addressing permissible automatic activation of hazard warning lamps. In parallel, Porsche investigated affected software versions, part numbers and vehicle populations.

On Oct. 6, 2021, Porsche determined that the subject vehicles do not comply with the definition of FMVSS No. 108 in the context of an automatic activation of warning hazard lights.

vehicles will be reprogrammed to remove the function. The owner's letter will not include a statement about customer reimbursement for prenotification remedies as all of the affected vehicles are still covered under
