**Replace Rear Window** 

Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year ("MY") 2021 GLE and GLS vehicles (167 platform), the rear window bonding might not meet specifications. Insufficient adhesion of the rear window to the tailgate could result in the rear window detaching, which could increase the risk of a crash for ensuing vehicles. Before the issue occurs, the customer might notice wind noises from the rear window. MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will replace the rear window

#### Prior to performing this Campaign:

- VMI must always be checked before performing campaigns to verify that the campaign is required on a specific vehicle. Always check for any other open campaigns, and perform accordingly.
- Please review the entire Campaign bulletin and follow the repair procedure exactly as described.
