IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 22V-009

Dear Oshkosh Vehicle Owner:

Ref: NHTSA U-Bolts Securing Front Axle May Fail 22V-009

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Oshkosh has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in your Oshkosh S-Series Front Discharge Mixer. These vehicles were built between 2018-2021.

!IMPORTANT!

Why is a recall being conducted?

A concern affecting safety exists in some Oshkosh S-Series Front Discharge Mixers. Trucks have been identified that are equipped with front axle U-bolts that were manufactured incorrectly and do not meet the required material specifications. The defect may cause the front axle U-bolts to loosen or fall off, resulting in the front axle shifting or the axle becoming dislocated from the vehicle. This bulletin provides instruction on replacing the front axle U-bolts.

What are we doing about the problem?

Oshkosh will provide customers with Instructions on how to install a new front axle U-Bolts. Customers would purchase the parts, perform the repairs, and then file parts/labor reimbursement through normal warranty process. Customers can also choose to have an Oshkosh service center perform the inspection and repair work free of charge.



What should you do?

- Repairs should take less than 1.5 hours.
- Customers can also choose to have an Oshkosh service center perform the inspection and repair work free of charge.
