Background						
Issue		Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that certain MY21 GLB-Class (247 platform) vehicles might not be equipped with the driver airbag module according to current production specifications. Depending on the driver airbag module installed, different consequences could result when the airbag deploys. If the driver airbag deploys, it might not provide its restraint function as intended. In addition, the airbag module might detach from its mounting location within the steering wheel hub during deployment and potentially contact occupants. Thus, in the event of a crash with a driver airbag deployment, the risk of injury to the occupants might be increased.				
What We're Doing		MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will check and replace the front driver airbag on the affected vehicles, if necessary.
