Repair Available – Compliance Recall 72M6 / Center Rear Seat Belt Wiring Harness

Issue: The wiring harness for the center rear seat belt buckle may be routed incorrectly and interfere with the inner lower LATCH anchor of the right rear seat. This may obstruct the accessibility of the lower child seat anchors and inhibit the child seat from being properly secured. Due to one of the lower child seat anchors not being accessible, a child seat on the right rear seat may not be properly secured increasing the risk of injury in case of a crash.

- Repair:**
- REPAIR AVAILABLE – March 04, 2022 – Inspect the wiring harness for the center rear seat belt buckle for damage and correctly route and secure it on the affected vehicles if necessary.
 - See ELSA/ServiceNet for complete repair & claiming instructions
 - Check daily campaign open inventory report or OMD for affected vehicles in inventory
 - Repair every affected inventory vehicle before delivery to consumers.

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
