Subject: Safety Recall RVXX2201, Volvo VN Sleeper Cabinets rev

Description of Defect:

On certain trucks, there is a potential for sleeper cabinets to pull away from walls, as bolts may have been installed without necessary washers.

In the event of an accident, the sleeper cabinets may pull free from the cab structure and potentially cause injury.

The repair will be an inspection of the mounting hardware and installation of the washer to the existing bolt as needed.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Certain 2022 and 2023 Volvo VN model vehicles manufactured from December 13, 2021 through January 12, 2022. Rev dates

Vehicle Quantities:

Volvo 227, (209 US, 18 Canada)

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal March 4, 2022.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before April 30, 2022.
