RE: Notice of Recall: NHTSA 22V156

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Roadtrek Inc. has decided that certain Roadtrek Inc. model year 2021 SS Agile model vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 138, "Tire Pressure Monitoring Systems." These vehicles were manufactured from Nov 13, 2020, through Nov 18, 2021, and built on the Mercedes Benz Sprinter Chassis. The Placard and Tire Pressure labels incorrectly state the front tire pressure to be 46 psi. **The correct front tire pressure is 52 psi** and this is what is stated in the owner's manual and is what the Tire Pressure Monitoring System should be set to. Incorrect front tire pressure could result in the vehicle stability control system not functioning correctly, or if the tires are inflated to the psi stated on the placard, tires may be underinflated increasing the risk of a crash.

New Placard labels and Tire Pressure labels will be issued to all dealers and owners that have vehicles with incorrect labels with instructions for these new labels to be installed over top of the incorrect labels. The label installation will take approximately 15 minutes. These labels will be provided free of charge.
