Issue: Specific soldering points on the flexible printed circuit assembled (FPCA) inside the HV battery may not establish a reliable connection due to manufacturing issues. Unreliable connections inside the HV battery may lead to breakdowns or stalling while driving in the field. This can lead to a crash without warning.

Precautions: If this issue is present in the vehicle, the driver would be alerted by a message appearing in the instrument panel warning about an issue in the high voltage system. Should this occur, owners are advised to make an appointment with their authorized Volkswagen dealer without delay to have the vehicle diagnosed/repaired.

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
