



## IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

### NHTSA Recall 22V-182

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Reading Truck has decided that a defect related to motor vehicle safety exists in your vehicle with the VIN stated above.

#### What Is the Concern?

Reading Truck is recalling certain 2019-2021 Master Mechanic Crane Body & Upfit vehicles. The Power Take Off (PTO) Timer Delay Relay module is mounted under the hood instead of in the vehicle cab, subjecting it to conditions which can lead to corrosion and cause the module to overheat.

#### What Should You Do?

The vehicle(s) listed were sold to you and have been identified as vehicle(s) that are subject to the potential part failure. Please confirm ownership of the vehicle(s) and follow either of the following steps:

1. If you are a qualified mechanic you have the option to follow the Field Inspection Instructions (FI 22-02) to have your current vehicle evaluated, and execute the repair yourself. This may be done by following the FI-63 Field Installation Instructions and completing all of the steps as described.

**OR**

2. Schedule appointment to have your vehicle inspected and repaired at an authorized Reading Truck location. Please email [warranty@readingtruck.com](mailto:warranty@readingtruck.com) or call 1-800-458-2226 (option 4). The repair will be completed at no cost to you.

#### How Long Will the Repair Take?

The inspection of your vehicle will not take more than 15 minutes. If having the repair completed at an authorized Reading Truck location the inspection and repair will be performed free of charge. If repair is required, it is recommended that you plan to leave your vehicle with the authorized Reading Truck location for approximately 1 hour to have the recall performed.

Field repairs performed by a qualified mechanic **must** follow the steps laid out in the Field Installation and Repair Instructions (FI-63). The repair is approved to be reimbursed for 30 minutes labor and the repair parts will be provided free of charge.

### **What to Do If You Feel You Received This Notice in Error?**

If you are not the current owner of the vehicle(s) identified on the enclosed list, please send email notification of the change of ownership to [warranty@readingtruck.com](mailto:warranty@readingtruck.com)

Please include the Reading Body Serial or Chassis VIN, as well as any information you can produce on the vehicle's new owner [Name, Address, and Phone#].

Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice forward it to the vehicle lessee within ten days.
