This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Jayco Inc. has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain model year 2022 White Hawk travel trailers.

Reason for Recall	The 50 Amp shore power inlet lug bolts may have been manufactured with excessively hard metal, preventing them from being tightened properly and resulting in a loose wiring connection. Loose wiring can cause an electrical short, increasing the risk of a fire.
Recall Remedy	Remedy consists of replacement of the 50 Amp shore power inlet. The remedy is free of charge and will take approximately 15 minutes to complete.
What we need you to do	Our records show the following unit is affected by this recall, and is part of the current inventory at your Dealership.
