## Condition

Certain Model 3 Performance vehicles with firmware version 2021.44.25 or later, but before version 2022.12, might not display the unit of speed (MPH or KM/H) on the touchscreen speedometer when Track Mode is activated.

## Correction

Inspect the vehicle firmware version, and if necessary, update the vehicle firmware to version 2022.12 or later.

## Procedure

On the vehicle touchscreen, touch **Controls** (vehicle icon) > **Software**, and then scroll down to display the vehicle firmware version.

- If the vehicle firmware version is before 2021.44.25, no action is necessary. Use correction code S012200008.
- If the vehicle firmware version is 2022.12 or later, no action is necessary. Use correction code S012200008.
- If the vehicle firmware version is 2021.44.25 or later, but before version 2022.12, update to version 2022.12 or later (refer to Service Manual procedure [00020003](#)). Use correction code S022200008.
