Seat Belt Pretensioner

This is an important Safety Recall.

- Failure to have this recall completed could lead to seat belt pretensioner explosion, which could seriously injure vehicle occupants.
- The recall will be performed on your vehicle at **NO CHARGE** to you.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Hyundai has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2020 – 2021 Accent, 2021 – 2022 Elantra, 2021 – 2022 model year Elantra HEV vehicles. Hyundai is initiating Recall 229, a safety recall to repair a condition involving the front seat belt pretensioners in these vehicles in the U.S. and Canadian markets. Hyundai is conducting this action to ensure the safety of its vehicles for Hyundai customers. Our records indicate that your vehicle is affected by this recall.

What is the problem?

The front seat belt pretensioner may deploy abnormally in the subject vehicles, causing the MGG (Micro Gas Generator) to detach from the assembly. An abnormal pyrotechnic pretensioner deployment could cause the pretensioner to explode, and project metal fragments into the vehicle occupant compartment, which may result in injury to vehicle occupants.

All vehicles in the population were also involved in Recalls 211, 219, 220, or 223. Vehicles that have had remedy repairs under the previous recalls will need to have the new remedy completed.

What will Hyundai do?

Your Hyundai dealer will install front seat belt pretensioner anti-separation protection caps. This procedure will be performed at **NO CHARGE** to you.

What should you do?

The actual time required to perform this procedure on your vehicle will take less than one hour, however, your vehicle may be needed longer. Therefore, we recommend scheduling a service appointment to minimize inconvenience.
