On or about May 25, 2022 – A review of warranty and field reports did not show any other reported failures. On or about May 27, 2022 – Elgin completed the investigation which revealed that some units in service may have the fan housing retention bolts not properly tightened. Out of an abundance of caution, Elgin decided to

conduct a voluntary safety recall.
