Subject: FCCC MT50e Park Brake

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the *National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act*.

Daimler Trucks North America LLC (DTNA), on behalf of its wholly owned subsidiary, Freightliner Custom Chassis Corporation, has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2022-2023 MT50e walk-in vans manufactured October 18, 2021, through June 24, 2022, and built with DANA E-Axles.

On certain MT50e walk-in vans, the park pawl may be broken or damaged, which could result in an unintended vehicle roll away, increasing the risk of crash or injury.

This is the first of two notices you will receive regarding this subject. This letter is to inform you of an upcoming Recall to correct the issue noted above. Daimler Trucks and Dana Incorporated are currently developing the repair and securing replacement parts. **There is no action for you to take at this time.**

The **second notice** will inform you when the remedy is available and provide you with steps for obtaining the free repair.

If you do not own the vehicle that corresponds to the identification number(s) which appears on the Recall Notification, please return the notification to the Warranty Campaigns Department with any information you can furnish that will assist us in locating the present owner. If you have leased this vehicle, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to the lessee within 10 days. If you are a subsequent stage manufacturer, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to your distributors and retail outlets within five working days.
