Subject: Stop Sale and Delivery Notice for Upcoming Safety Recall

Affected Models: 2022MY Isuzu FTR Vehicles (See affected 11 VINs below)

To: Isuzu Dealer Principal, Sales Manager and Service Manager

Effective immediately, stop the sale and delivery of affected vehicles in your inventory, even if a customer has purchased an affected vehicle. We are in the process of taking steps to address a safety related defect in these vehicles. Federal law prohibits the sale and delivery to customers of any vehicle containing a safety defect. You must not deliver any covered vehicles to customers until after the vehicle has been remedied.

WHAT IS THE CONDITION?

Isuzu Motors Limited has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2022MY Isuzu FTR vehicles. Due to a software calibration error, the affected vehicles were built without engine braking functionality, which may cause a driver to experience longer stopping distances than expected and **could lead to a crash.**

WHAT WE WILL DO

Isuzu Commercial Truck of America, Inc. has issued this notice and affected inventory reports for dealers with affected inventory.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

Confirm the affected vehicles in your (dealer) inventory, open a repair order referencing this Stop Sale and wait for additional instructions.

IMPORTANT: Always confirm vehicle eligibility prior to beginning repairs by using the Isuzu Vehicle Information System (IVIS).

You will receive another notice regarding owner notification as well as a campaign bulletin containing a sample owner letter once it has been approved by NHTSA.
