attached to the awning frame. This could allow the awning to drop and extend beyond normal operation. An awning that drops or extends beyond normal

operation can increase the risk of injury.

Description of the Cause: Insufficient weld penetration in some areas between the fabric and the

adjoining PVC extruded track.
