snow and/or ice.

Description of the Safety Risk: Intermittent or inoperative windshield wipers could reduce driver visibility

while operating the vehicle in inclement weather, increasing the risk of a

crash.

Description of the Cause: The root cause is currently under investigation; however, Hyundai suspects a

sudden increase in wiper system load could cause circuit breaker actuation within the wiper motor resulting in temporary inoperability. Wiper operation resumes once the circuit breaker resets and/or the windshield is cleared of

obstructions.
