Issue Description

On the affected vehicles, it is possible that a sealing

cap which prevents the horizontal adjustment of the main headlights was not fitted during vehicle assemb-

ly.

If this is the case, certain legal requirements in the

USA and Canada markets are not met.

In order to bring the main headlights into compliance with the legal requirements, the installation of the sealing cap must be checked and, if necessary, a sealing cap must be retrofitted to the adjusting screw for the

horizontal adjustment of the headlights.

What Should Dealers do? The repair is not available at this time.

This issue does not affected new vehicle inventory.

With respect to pre-owned vehicle inventory, Porsche typically requests that dealers NOT deliver any preowned vehicles in dealer inventory prior to remedy. In What will Porsche Do?

The quality of our cars is one of the central commitments we make to our customers. For this reason, we regularly review our work. In the course of these reviews, it was discovered that in certain instances, a sealing cap meant to prevent headlights from being incorrectly adjusted was missing. The cap is applied in cars bound for the U.S. market to comply with different headlight regulations than those in effect in other countries. When properly installed, the cap prevents headlamps from being mechanically adjusted horizontally, to the left or right.

While no incidents have been reported, we will check the headlamps of affected cars and install the required sealing caps if they are missing. Customers can continue to use their vehicles until the remedy has been carried out. Customers whose cars are affected will be contacted in due course for the work to be done on a date convenient to them. There will be no charge for this work.
