## **IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 22V-716**

Dear McNeilus Vehicle Owner: Ref: NHTSA Ejector Welds May Fail 22V-716 VIN: <<NOTE: Either insert VIN or reference attached VIN list>>

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

McNeilus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2021-2023 McNeilus ZR side loaders. These vehicles were built between 6/1/2020- 8/1/2022.

## **!IMPORTANT!**

> Your McNeilus vehicle is being recalled.

Why is a recall McNeilus has identified that some vehicles were manufactured with ejector welds that do not meet internal specifications. Over time it could allow for movement of a hydraulic cylinder and ejector outside its normal operation inside the refuse body. If the weldment fails and breaks, pressure and force on the hydraulic cylinder can cause it to penetrate through the side of the truck body. This may increase the risk of injury to individuals in the vicinity of the side of the truck.

What are we<br/>doing about the<br/>problem?McNeilus will provide customers with instructions on how to install a new<br/>ejector panel. This procedure will be mailed out separately at a later date.<br/>Customers would purchase the parts, perform the repairs, and then file<br/>parts/labor reimbursement through normal warranty process. Customers<br/>can also choose to have a McNeilus service center perform the repair work<br/>free of charge.
