



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – Z95

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2022 Model Year (DT) Ram 1500 Pickup, 2021 Model Year (JL) Jeep Wrangler, and 2022 Model Year (JT) Jeep Gladiator vehicles.

VINs identified as being involved in this campaign are currently live and searchable. **Stop sale is in effect for the above-identified vehicles**.

Vehicles impacted by a stop sale are eligible for reimbursement allowance through the Recall Floorplan Reimbursement Policy (RFPRP), which can be requested upon recall claim submission.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: Some of the involved vehicles may be in dealer new vehicle inventory. Federal law requires you to complete this recall service on these vehicles before retail delivery. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to \$21,000 per vehicle. Involved vehicles can be determined by using the VIP inquiry process.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles front seat belt retractors may have been built with a Micro Gas Generator (MGG) that was incorrectly welded. An incorrectly welded MGG may lead to a pretensioner system failure. Pretensioner system failure may result in reduced occupant restraint during a vehicle crash, potentially increasing the risk of injury.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace suspect front seat belt retractors in all affected vehicles. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 4th Quarter of 2022.

We ask that you please take the time to ensure that your personnel are aware of this communication and are prepared to execute a customer friendly process for inquiries regarding involved vehicles.

Front Seat Belt Retractor

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

FCA US LLC has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain [2022 Model Year (DT) Ram 1500 Pickup, 2021 Model Year (JL) Jeep Wrangler, and 2022 Model Year (JT) Jeep Gladiator] vehicles.

It is extremely important to take steps now to repair your vehicle to ensure the safety of you and your passengers.

WHY DOES MY VEHICLE NEED REPAIRS?

The front seat belt retractor on your vehicle [1] may have an incorrectly welded Micro Gas Generator (MGG). An incorrectly welded MGG may lead to a pretensioner system failure. Pretensioner system failure may result in reduced occupant restraint during a vehicle crash, potentially increasing the risk of injury.

HOW DO I RESOLVE THIS IMPORTANT SAFETY ISSUE?

FCA US will repair your vehicle ^[2] free of charge (parts and labor). To do this, your dealer will replace the seat belt retractor. The estimated repair time is one hour. In addition, your dealer will require your vehicle for proper check-in, preparation, and check-out during your visit, which may require more time. Your time is important to us, so we recommend that you **schedule** a **service appointment on or after December 15**th to minimize your inconvenience. Please bring this letter with you to your dealership.

WHAT IF I ALREADY PAID TO HAVE THIS REPAIR COMPLETED?

If you have already experienced this specific condition and have paid to have it repaired, you may visit www.fcarecallreimbursement.com to submit your reimbursement request online. [3] Once we receive and verify the required documents, reimbursement will be sent to you within 60 days. If you have had previous repairs performed and/or already received reimbursement, you may still need to have the recall repair performed.
