



IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

December 2022

This notice applies to your vehicles, **VINs noted in the attached.**

Dear BrightDrop Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

General Motors has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2022 model year BrightDrop EV600 vehicles. As a result, GM is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for this inconvenience. However, we are concerned about your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.

IMPORTANT

- Your vehicle is involved in GM safety recall N222380032.
- Until the recall remedy is available, your vehicle can be driven and charged normally. But as a precaution, do not drive your vehicle through deep water (over 24 inches deep).

Why is your vehicle being recalled?

In some of the recalled vehicles, the high-voltage battery pack enclosure may not have been properly sealed. If the pack enclosure is not sealed, water can enter the pack. If water enters the battery pack enclosure, one or more malfunction indicator lamps may illuminate and the driver information center may display a warning message to the driver. Your vehicle may not start or could lose propulsion while driving. A loss of propulsion while driving can increase the risk of a crash.

What will we do?

GM is working to develop a remedy for this condition. When the remedy and parts are available, we will send you another letter asking you to take your vehicle to your BrightDrop dealer to have your vehicle serviced.
