IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL (Remedy Notice)

**Certain 2022 Model Year Porsche 911 GT3 Vehicles
Porsche Recall ANB6 / NHTSA ID 22V-803**

Dear [REDACTED] [REDACTED]:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Porsche has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2022 Model Year Porsche 911 GT3 and GT3 Touring Vehicles.

What is the issue?

Due to an assembly process deviation that has since been corrected, on some of the potentially affected vehicles equipped with optional Full Bucket Seats, the screw attaching the lower seatbelt anchor to the seat frame may not have been tightened to the specification. If the lower anchor screw loosens, in the event of a crash, the seatbelt anchor could detach from the seat, increasing the risk of injury.

What will Porsche do?

To help prevent this issue from occurring, Porsche will replace the screws attaching the lower seatbelt anchor to the seat frames and tighten the screws to the specifications. If the thread is damaged, the seat frame will also be replaced. This repair should take approximately 2 hours to complete, however, it may be necessary to make your vehicle available to your dealer for a longer period of time. Your Porsche dealer will arrange for alternate transportation if necessary.

What if you are not the owner or operator of this vehicle?

If you are the lessor and registered owner of the vehicle identified in this action, the law requires you to forward this letter immediately via first-class mail to the lessee within ten days of receipt. If you have changed your address or sold the vehicle, please contact customer support so we can update our records.

What should you do?

The remedy needed to complete this recall is now available.

Please contact any authorized Porsche dealer to schedule an appointment to have this recall performed as soon as possible and to arrange for Porsche-provided alternate transportation, if necessary.
