IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL ADVANCE NOTICE



Date: December 2, 2022

To: All Winnebago Dealers

Subject: **NHTSA Safety Recall 22V-884**

Issue: Winnebago has decided that a noncompliance exists on certain 2021-2022 Minnie and 2021-2022 Voyage travel trailers. The cargo carrying capacity label (CCC) on the trailer could show an incorrect load carrying capacity, which could lead to an unintentional overloading of the vehicle. An overloaded trailer can increase the risk of a crash. This is a non-compliance with a 49 CFR 571.110 / 49 CFR 571.120.

Owner Notification: Owners will be notified of this campaign by Winnebago Towables by the end of the year.

Dealer Responsibility Do not deliver any subject trailer until corrective action has been taken. All vehicles subject to this campaign are to be serviced at no charge to the owners regardless of mileage, age of vehicle, or ownership from this time forward.

Notes **Important Reminder:** It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification until the noncompliance is remedied.
