This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

McLaren Automotive Incorporated (“**McLaren**”) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model Year 2023 McLaren Artura vehicles. According to our records, you are the owner of one of those vehicles.

McLaren has determined that the nut used to secure the fuel pipe to the gasoline direct injection fuel pump may become loose and leak fuel. A fuel leak in the presence of an ignition source, such as hot engine components, can increase the risk of a fire.

YOUR AFFECTED VEHICLE

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT HOW YOUR VEHICLE IS AFFECTED

Please note the following:

Based on all of the information available to us, your Artura can continue to be driven under standard road conditions. However, we would recommend the repairs are carried out as soon as possible. McLaren are only aware of this issue occurring under heavy vehicle load such as track driving, which we would recommend is avoided until the remedial action is carried out.

WHAT WORK IS REQUIRED ON MY VEHICLE?

McLaren will replace the high-pressure fuel pipes with replacement fuel pipes that use alternative nuts made with a different material and manufacturing technique. We anticipate this remedial work taking two days to complete.

This remedy will be performed at no cost to you.

WHAT MCLAREN ASKS FROM YOU

Please contact your preferred McLaren retailer as soon as possible to schedule an appointment to have the recall completed on your vehicle. Details of your nearest McLaren retailer can be found by visiting the McLaren Automotive website - <https://retailers.mclaren.com/en>.

Your retailer will be aware of the recall that is required for your McLaren Artura, however, if possible, we recommend that you present this notification at the time of your scheduled appointment.
