Issue Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has dete on certain Model Year ("MY") 2021-2022 GLE and GLS (167 platform) vehicles, t coupling locking screw might not be tightened to the specified torque value. Insufficien torque of the steering coupling locking screw might lead to free play in the connect would cause noises when driving on uneven roads. Should these noises not be r therefore the vehicle not be brought to a workshop, the steering coupling locking subsequently loosen further due to vibrations during driving and ultimately might bac steering coupling. In this condition, it cannot be fully ruled out that the steering co detach from the steering shaft. This would impair the ability to steer the vehicle, and i risk of a crash.
