

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Electric Power Control Unit

This notice applies to your 2021 Hyundai Kona EV vehicle, VIN: XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX

This is an important Safety Recall.

- Failure to complete this recall repair could result in triggering of the vehicle's limited mobility "fail safe" drive mode and a sudden loss of drive power or vehicle stall, which could increase the risk of a crash.
- The repair procedure will be performed on your vehicle at **NO CHARGE** to you.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Hyundai has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain **2021 Model Year Kona EV vehicles**. To ensure the safety of its vehicles for Hyundai customers, we are initiating Safety Recall 239 to repair a condition involving the Electric Power Control Unit in these vehicles in the U.S. Our records indicate that your vehicle is affected by this recall.

What is the problem?

The Electric Power Control Unit ("EPCU") may have been improperly sealed, causing an internal coolant leak and contamination of the EPCU main controller. Contamination of the EPCU controller could result in triggering of the vehicle's limited mobility "fail safe" drive mode and a sudden loss of drive power or vehicle stall, which could increase the risk of a crash.

What will Hyundai do?

Your Hyundai dealer will inspect the EPCU and replace it, if necessary. This procedure will be performed at **NO CHARGE** to you.

What should you do?

Please contact your nearest Hyundai dealer to schedule this procedure.

The actual time required to perform this procedure on your vehicle will take less than one hour, however, your vehicle may be needed longer. To find your Hyundai dealer in order to schedule an appointment:

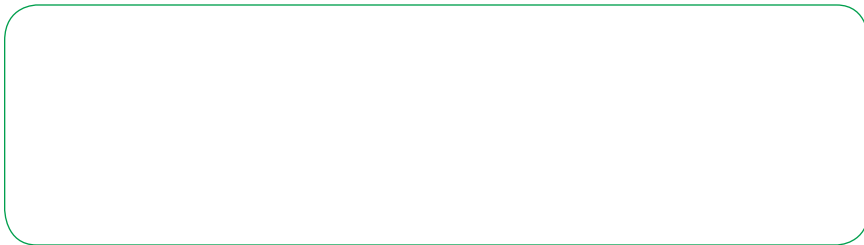
