



Q&A for SDS2 3031/3032 Recall – active list of questions we are getting and answers, this will ensure we are communicating the same message to all customers.

- 1. What risk mitigation can our customers take if they have a vehicle impacted by this Suburban recall?
 - a. The customer should discontinue use of their cooktop.
- 2. Is there any risk of leak if the propane is on to the unit and the cooktop dials remain in the off position?
 - a. The recall does not impact this risk. If the knobs are off there should be no gas flowing through the regulator. There is always a risk in the connection of the supply line to the unit but this recall does not impact that risk.
- 3. What if I have units on my lot with and 3032AST's?
 - a. You can order 3333AST's to replace them and we will do a RGA and take the 3032AST's back.
- 4. Some customers have a remedy that says Suburban will replace the cooktop free of charge with a new unit.
 - a. This remedy is incorrect. See Publication 573 NHTSA Campaign Number: 23E-002
- 5. Is 3031AST under the recall?
 - a. Yes the replacement model is 3334AST
- 6. Is there a field fix remedy yet?
 - a. Yes as of 2/28/23 we have a field remedy defined, Kits will be available to order and ship on 3/3/2023.
 - b. The kit number is 521337 for 3032AST
 - c. The kit number is 521340 for 3031AST
